- College preparatory focus beginning in Kindergarten, including trips to colleges and universities and an unwavering understanding by every Scholar that “I am college bound!”
- Academically intensive environment, providing 3-5 additional hours of instruction daily
- Minimum of 160 minutes of literacy and 100 minutes of math instruction every day beginning in Kindergarten
- Two-teacher classroom model in grades K-2
